### Exceeding NYS and District Standards

Students who receive a 4 are excelling in the standard for their grade level. They consistently show advanced understanding of concepts and skills. These students take initiative, challenge themselves and demonstrate accelerated knowledge of content. A 4 indicates an exceptionally high achievement, beyond “good grades”.

### Meeting NYS and District Standards

Students who receive a 3 are proficient in the standard and are demonstrating a level of understanding that is typically/appropriately expected and sufficient during the course of the current Marking Period.

### Developing Towards NYS and District Standards

Students who receive a 2 are partially proficient in standards for their grade. They demonstrate knowledge, skills and practices embodied by the NYS and district standards but require regular support, monitoring and/or assistance from an adult to progress.

### Not Meeting NYS and District Standards

Students receiving a 1 are still acquiring the pre-requisite skills in order to understand the content and/or apply the skills of the grade level standard. Students need additional adult assistance, increased time, smaller chunks of learning and/or alternative strategies for gaining foundational standards that will lead to the grade level standard.
