Senior Awards: Chorus

The *Navy Music Achievement Award* is given yearly by the United States Navy to a senior who has shown great achievement in music. This year's winner is Colleen Beamish.

The *Director's Award for Chorus* is a new Choral award given this year. This award honors outstanding members of a senior high school chorus.

The *Fred Waring Director's Award for Chorus* is the second highest honor for seniors in the choral program. Fred Waring (1900-1984) was one of the leading choral directors of the 20th century. He composed and arranged music, and his choral group, The Pennsylvanians, spread the popularity of singing. His name was recently added to the Director's Award for Chorus with the endorsement of his widow Virginia. The Fred Waring Director's Award for Chorus recognizes the talent and enthusiasm of outstanding choral members.

The *National School Choral Award* is the highest honor for high school choral performers. It recognizes the dedication and musical achievement of the top choral students.

Outstanding Musicianship - The outstanding musicianship awards goes to students who take pride in their musical endeavors and participate in several different performing ensembles. They work hard to refine their talent, know their parts well and serve as excellent role models for others in their group.

Breakout Performance - These individuals stood out in their performances or behind the scenes work for the different events we held this year.

Certificates of Recognition: Senior Class Senior Class Showcase Awards Senior Awards: Band

The ***Sempre Fidelis Award*** is given yearly by the United States Marines Youth Foundation to seniors showing excellence in musicianship and leadership.

The ***Patrick S. Gilmore Award*** was established in 1994, the award aims to recognize seniors who exemplify the ideals of Patrick S. Gilmore (1829-1892). Gilmore led the way for Sousa's success and was "instrumental" in creating the modern wind band.

The ***Director's Award for Band*** is the second highest honor for seniors in the band program. The recipient must demonstrate dedication, loyalty, character, and discipline to the band program.

The ***John Phillip Sousa Award*** is the highest honor a senior in the band program can receive. The student must demonstrate the highest levels of dedication, loyalty, character, and discipline to the band program while achieving the highest musical standards required of instrumental music.

Most Improved - Most Improved is given to the students who have shown a tremendous amount of growth and continued success in the program since the beginning of the school year.

Above and Beyond - The Above and Beyond award is being given to students who go the extra mile to ensure that each and every one of their performances is top-notch, they are deeply committed to their work in music and the arts.

Most Versatile - The Most Versatile Award is given to students who wear many hats in their respective ensembles. This is a student who challenges themselves to try new things and experiment with a variety of musical feats! They are able to move effortlessly from one voice part, instrument or musical style.

Spirit Award - The Spirit award is given to students who demonstrate a genuine love of music, who are always eager to begin rehearsing and are enthusiastic about participating in all activities related to music!

Rookie of the Year - Rookie of the year is presented to an outstanding 7th, 9th grader or a new student to the program who shows great potential in music and is a true asset to their performing ensembles.

Outstanding Service-This award for outstanding service is presented to a student who gives selflessly to the music program. Countless hours of free time are sacrificed for the benefit of the department. In an attempt to stay connected to the department despite a scheduling conflict this year, this student has helped set up and break down of all of our events and worked our fundraisers.

Awards Include:

All-County Participants – These students were selected among a huge pool of applications from all of the schools in Rensselaer County to perform in either the Fall or Winter Festival.

NYSSMA Participants – students who took a risk and worked hard on a solo or chamber piece to play for expert judges and get a score. All students received at least a rating of Excellent or higher

Area-All State Participants - This fall, Hoosic Valley had three students selected to participate in the Area-All State Music Festival. These students were selected from a large pool of students from all of the schools in our zone, based on their NYSSMA Solo Score from last spring.

Empire State Youth Orchestra Participants - Empire State Youth Orchestras' mission is to challenge and inspire young people to achieve excellence in music through intensive instruction and high level performance opportunities. These auditioned groups are of extremely high caliber, and we are proud to have two students as members of this organization,

Empire State Youth Chorale Participants – One of our Hoosic Valley students auditioned for and were accepted to the prestigious Empire State Youth Chorale, that performs at the Melodies of Christmas each year.

NAfME Electronic Music Competition - Divided in three categories, K-8, 9-12, and Collegiate, students from across the country submit original compositions based primarily in Electronic Music. NAfME chooses one winner and one honorable mention for each category.

General Music Awards – given to students who excelled at either the theatre, piano, guitar or ukulele unit.

School Service Awards – given to students who have served as teaching assistance in the music department this year

Independent Chorus Award – Despite scheduling conflicts, this student still gave 100% and learned all of the performance music for the year.
