CAPS AND GOWNS

Monday, June 12th - Caps and gowns will be distributed in the morning during your senior breakfast in the Main Office. Please take these items home and prepare for graduation (i.e.: remove wrinkles from gown and put on hanger). If you are unable to secure your graduation attire at this time, please contact Mrs. Lewis in the Main Office. You will be required to sign for your graduation attire when you receive it. **You will be required to return your gown at the conclusion of graduation.** Representatives from Joster's will be at the Saratoga City Center to collect your gowns. The cap & tassel will be yours to keep!

BACCALAUREATE SERVICE (optional for students)

Wednesday, June 21st - The ceremony will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m.. Seniors are expected to arrive at the Hoosic Valley Community Church, Rt. 40, Schaghticoke by 6:30 p.m. **with their cap and gown.** Please have gown ironed. GRADUATION REHEARSAL and PICTURE

Thursday, June 22nd @ 9:00 a.m. in the gymnasium. **THIS REHEARSAL IS MANDATORY FOR ALL GRADUATING SENIORS.** Please allow approximately two (2) hours for the picture and rehearsal. All final details regarding the processional, rehearsal, seating and diplomas will be reviewed at this time.

Graduation Picture - Thursday, June 22nd @ 9:00 a.m. just prior to rehearsal. **Cap and gown are worn for the picture.** Also, male graduates should wear or bring a shirt with a collar to wear under the gown and all students should wear nice dress shoes for the picture. The picture, which is normally purchased individually, will be provided for each graduate, free of charge at graduation. These are compliments of the Class of 2017!

GRADUATION

Friday, June 23rd, at 6:00 p.m. at the Saratoga Springs City Center, 522 Broadway, Saratoga Springs, NY. **Seniors are expected to be at the City Center ready for rehearsal by 4:15 p.m.** The graduates will have this time to briefly practice the processional prior to guests entering the Main Hall. The doors to the Main Hall for seating will not be open to families and guests of the graduates until approximately 5:30 p.m., following the graduate's rehearsal. Due to the large capacity for graduation seating at the City Center, tickets are not required for seating.

Dress Information - Graduates will be required to wear appropriate clothes and shoes for the Baccalaureate Service and the Graduation Ceremony. Remember that the clothing worn under your gowns will be visible as the gowns are loose fitting. Male graduates - a dress shirt, tie, nice pants (khakis are fine or dress pants) and **dress shoes.** Female graduates - dress shoes with your appropriate attire. If you should have any difficulty securing these items, please see your advisors (Mr. Spooner or Mrs. Anderson) or Mrs. Lewis as soon as possible. **If you attend graduation with inappropriate attire and/or shoes, you may not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremonies.** **Graduation caps are NOT to be decorated for the graduation ceremony.** Please save your decorations for after graduation. **Seniors will not be permitted to wear: jeans, shorts, sneakers, rubber flip-flops or t-shirts.**

Parking - Free parking is available in the following locations: on Walton Street (two blocks west of Broadway) and between Church Street and Division Street (one block west of Broadway), and lots between High Rock and Maple. Elderly and disabled guests can be dropped off in front of the City Center on the Broadway side. Please allow yourself sufficient time to find a parking space.
